St. Felix Pantry began with Sr. Genevieve. As a child she would share bread with her neighbors. That desire to help those in need never went away. She joined the Felician Sisters, and after moving to Rio Rancho saw a need to share bread with her neighbors again. She picked up day old bread from local businesses and distributed it to people in need from the trunk of her car. Over time the program expanded into a one-car garage and eventually to the current buildings on Barbara Loop SE.

Today we continue Sr. Genevieve's dream to give bread and other food to the hungry in our community.

RECENT HIGHLIGHTS
